

Grammar Lesson #9

Imperative conjugate of Hollow Verbs

Recall: a hollow verb is a verb that has a vowel (يُورُوا) in its middle

أَنْتُمْ you (fm.pl.)	أَنْتُمْ you (ms.pl.)	أَنْتُمَا you (dual)	أَنْتِ you (fm.sg)	أَنْتِ you (ms.sg)	تَنَامِ تَنَامِي تَنَامُوا تَنَامُونَ تَنَامِينَ to sleep
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سِيرِي سِيرِي سِيرُوا سِيرُونَ سِيرِينَ to walk
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قُمِي قُمِي قُمُوا قُمُونَ قُمِينَ to rise

اسْتَقِي اسْتَقِي اسْتَقِي اسْتَقِي اسْتَقِي to be straight
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Note: the vowel is deleted for the (ms.sg) & (fm.pl.)

Drill: conjugate as above the verbs:

(i) يَخَافُ (to fear) (ii) يَبِيعُ (to sell)

(iii) يَسْجُدُ (to swim) (iv) يَسْتَعِينُ (to seek assistance)
