

دُعَاءُ (٢)

[to be said at the end of meetings]

Reported by Ibn Omar

اللَّهُمَّ اقْبِهِ لَنَا مِنْ خَشْيَتِكَ مَا تَحُولُ بِهِ
بَيْنَنَا وَبَيْنَ مَعْصِيكَ

O Allah: Let us have fear of You that keeps us away
from any act of disobeying You;

وَمِنْ طَاعَتِكَ مَا تُبَلِّغُنَا بِهِ جَنَّتِكَ

And [let us have] acts of obeying You for which
You admit us to Your Jannah;

وَمِنَ الْيَقِينِ مَا تَهَوِّنُ بِهِ عَلَيْنَا مُصِيبَاتِ الدُّنْيَا

And [let us have] firm belief that eases on us
the impact of the worldly misfortunes

وَمَتِّعْنَا بِأَسْمَاعِنَا وَأَبْصَارِنَا وَقُوَّتِنَا مَا أَحْيَيْتَنَا
وَاجْعَلْهُ الْوَارِثَ مِنَّا

And grant us enjoyment of our hearing, our sight,
and our strength as long as You keep us alive

وَأَجْعَلْ تَأْرُنَا عَلَى مَنْ ظَلَمْنَا

and let our revenge be restricted to those who treated us unjustly;

وَأَنْصُرْنَا عَلَى مَنْ عَادَانَا

and support us against those who showed enmity towards us;

وَلَا تَجْعَلْ مُصِيبَتَنَا فِي دِينِنَا

and let not our misfortune be in our "Deen";

وَلَا تَجْعَلِ الدُّنْيَا أَكْبَرَ كَهْمِنَا وَلَا مَبْلَغَ عِلْمِنَا

and let not the worldly life be our top preoccupation nor the extent of our knowledge

وَلَا تُسَلِّطْ عَلَيْنَا مَنْ لَكَ يَرْحَمُنَا

and do not empower over us those who have no mercy towards us.

Note: This "hadith" is reported in "Jami Al-Tirmidhi" *بِإِسْنَادٍ تَرْمِذِيٍّ*

and ranked as "hassan" *حَسَنٌ* [good].

Ibn Umar, the companion who ~~was~~ heard the "hadith" said that the Prophet used to say this duaa when leaving a meeting with his companions.
